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Statement of Jane Doe 17

I was too young to have ever been familiar with who Ron Jeremy was and what he did for a living. He was not an adult film star to me. He was my assailant.

Pornographic careers are built upon consensual sex, but I can assure you that there was nothing consensual about what I endured with Ron Jeremy.

I was 21 and it was New Year's Eve, 2020. I am Jane Doe 17.

Now I stand before the court and wonder if there is any kind of justice at all for me. What Ron Jeremy did to me will forever stay with me, and I will never forget what he did to me.

Ron Jeremy was at the bar at a New Year's Eve party that I was attending. He seemed like a regular person. Some people even seemed to be excited that he was there, but I didn't know why they were excited. My friend left me to go to the restroom. Ron Jeremy approached me, grabbed my arm, and told me that he had to show me something and that it was urgent. I was worried something could have been wrong. I was worried someone outside could have been hurt.

Once outside, I noticed we were the only two people there. He then proceeded to tell me that he was ready to show me the thing he mentioned inside. He pulled his pants down and began to flex his penis. I was surprised and disgusted, and frightened.

I had had too much to drink that New Year's Eve. It was dark, and now, we stood in the middle of some park. I didn't know where I was. I was so scared. He held me down. He groped me. I didn't know what else he was capable of. I had no idea where I was, where my friend was. All I wanted to do was get back. But I

couldn't get back. It was so dark, and I didn't know where to go. Before I knew it, he sexually assaulted me. When he was assaulting me, I kept asking him to stop, that he was hurting me, but he wouldn't stop.

I told my friends what happened that night, and I was glad when the criminal case was brought against Ron Jeremy. I was willing to testify at his trial, and I hoped for justice because I wanted Ron Jeremy to have to pay the consequences for what he did to me and other women.
