I was in New Orleans with my wife for Mardi Gras.

When my wife told me that she had been raped I was shocked. I accompanied her to the hospital. I observed her injuries and spoke to the examining nurse and physician at the hospital where a rape kit was performed. I was in the room when she was being examined. I am a physician. All the signs were consistent with my wife having been raped.

After the detective told my wife that it was consensual I spoke with him. I was in disbelief. I asked him how could he come to that conclusion. The only thing he said was that he had spoken to the security guard who admitted having sex with my wife, but since he said that it was consensual that was it.

I tried to reach the detective's supervisor, but he never called me back.

I am here to support my wife and to seek justice for her. We have been together for ten years. We have a large family. Nothing like this has ever happened before. We love New Orleans and we have always had a great time here.
